This six module 2 year programme is run under the personal direction of Dr Neil and Dr Silverberg and will run sessions involving the relationship between physical and emotional and family wellbeing.

The aims are: to help you formulate the Satir Model into a systematic brief therapy model; to practice Satir's experiential therapy for therapeutic and organisational use; to increase your therapeutic skills in working with individuals, couples, and families; to integrate family dynamics and change to bring about transformation.

Participants who complete the full two year program six modules as training are awarded a Diploma of Counselling by The Satir Centre of Australia and eligible to membership in AVANTA. Members of the Australian Psychological Society may apply for professional development. Fees are payable upon acceptance of application. Enrolment in a single module is not possible.
